3rd MARCH, 1951.

1. War gratuity remaining for payment under the War Gratuity Act 1945-1947 together with interest accrued thereon, is payable on the due date—3rd March, 1951.
2. Payment will be made only into a Bank Account nominated by the person entitled to the gratuity.
2. Where no Bank Account is already held, an Account in the name of the person entitled to gratuity will be opened in a Savings Bank nominated by him (or her).
4. Except as provided in Item 7 below, war gratuity will be paid only to an account in the name in which the gratuity credit is recorded in the Register of War Gratuities.

5. Marriage of a Female Grantee.

Where an ex-servicewoman has married since credit of gratuity was made, her marriage certificate, if not already sighted by the War Gratuity Officer, must be forwarded with this form. The certificate will be returned immediately the change of name has been recorded in the Register.

6. Members who died prior to 3rd March, 1946.

Where a member of the Forces died prior to 3rd March, 1946, all unpaid gratuity will be paid to the Bank Account of the person or persons in whose name or names the gratuity credit is recorded in the Register. In these cases separate forms should be completed by each person to whom an Advice of War Gratuity Entitlement was issued.

7. Death of a person after credit of gratuity has been made in his or her name.

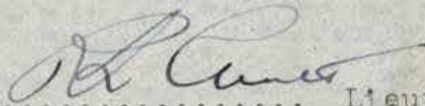

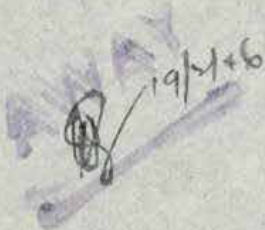

This will enable the matter to be satisfactorily dealt with in the event of the wife making a claim.

As far as the Department is concerned, the above allotment will be regarded as an absolute one, and no liability or obligation is accepted by the Department as to any misapplication of same by the Allottee. If, however, the member has made any private arrangement with the Allottee, as to the disposal of the allotment money, he may avail himself of the provisions made hereunder for recording same, which would, in the case of the member's death, and dispute arising amongst persons interested, supply definite information of the member's actual intention in making the allotment.

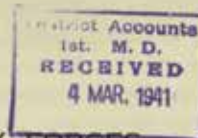
